The Research Department of Bank Al-Maghrib, the INREDD research lab of the Cadi Ayyad University of Marrakech and the Bernoulli Center for Economics of the University of Basel invite submissions for the third edition of the **International Days of Macroeconomics and Finance**. The event will take place the 23rd and 24th April 2018 at the Centre de Formation Professionnelle of Bank Al-Maghrib in Rabat, Morocco. The objective of these days is to foster a productive exchange between researchers and decision-makers and to formulate recommendations to address critical economic policy issues.

Contributions are welcome from all areas of macroeconomics and finance. Both theoretical and empirical papers will be considered. This year's edition will give priority to papers related to the theme "Finance for growth". The choice of this theme is motivated by the debates on the difficulties of access of small and medium enterprises to external funds and the emergence of new modes of financing.

Submission of papers

The deadline for completed papers submission is January 31st, 2018. Interested authors should submit their papers in electronic form (PDF) to jimf.marrakech@gmail.com. Authors of submitted papers will be notified with the decision of the scientific committee before February 22nd, 2018. Papers can be presented in French or English. The list of selected papers will be published on the website of the conference.
